



YOUR RACE NUMBER

Your race number is included with this instruction sheet. Be sure that all the information on the tag at the bottom of the number is correct. If you need to make corrections, take it back to the registration table. Please wear your race number on the front, and do not cover it up or fold it.

YOUR CHAMPIONCHIP

Make sure that your race number agrees with the number on the ChampionChip that you will receive on Raceday. Attach the chip to your shoe lace with the velcro strip. After you cross the finish mats, remove the chip and velcro strap and place them in the buckets as you exit. Remember that you must return the chip after the race or you will be required to pay the replacement cost of **\$30.00**.
